Dear Parents/Carers,

As part of our KS1 science unit 'Animals and their habitats', we will be visiting Yorkshire Wildlife Park on Thursday 22nd May.

Children will have a tour of the animals and an animal habitat and adaptation workshop session.

To keep the cost of this wonderful trip to a minimum we are asking that you drop your child off at the entrance of Yorkshire Wildlife Park. If we were to use a coach this would be approximately £700, making the trip very costly.

Staff will meet you at the entrance of YWP between 9:15-9:30am (allowing parents to drop any siblings off at school first). The children will require a packed lunch for the day. If you require a packed lunch provided by school please inform Miss Eade or Mrs Mitchell by Friday 16th May. Please collect your child from YWP at 2:30pm – allowing time for you to return to school for any other children. We advise that the children wear comfortable and weather-suitable shoes with their school uniform. Please ensure they have sun hats/sun cream and also raincoat to be prepared for all weather.

The cost of the session is £10.30 per child. We ask that this is please paid via your ParentPay account by Friday 16th May so that the children can enjoy this wonderful experience. We are really excited and hope you will check photos we share on the school social media accounts, to enjoy the experience with us!
