Reminders

Uniform – Please ensure your child has the correct uniform for September. Logoed items are optional for all pieces of uniform except PE tops which must have the school logo to identify our children when competing with other schools. Further detail of our uniform are available on the website.

Breakfast and After School Clubs – We are pleased to announce that the earlier starting time for our breakfast club has been working well and will continue next year. The starting **time** is **7.45** am and sessions will remain £3.50. Drop-in sessions for breakfast club are from **8.30** am and still **cost** £1.

Afterschool club will continue to run from 3.15 to 5.45, but we will be making a small increase in the prices. 3.15 to 4.30 will now cost £5.00 and 3.15 to 5.45 will cost £8.00

To enable our successful clubs to continue to run smoothly, please could all parents and carers make sure they give 24 hours' notice to cancel a pre booked place, otherwise your ParentPay account will be charged, unless the cancellation is due to your child being too ill to attend school. Can you also make sure places are paid for in advance.

Children having packed lunches

Please can you ensure that your child **does not bring nuts, or food containing nuts into school**, as we have several children with severe allergies to them. Could you also make sure your child has a drink and any cutlery they need to eat their packed lunch.
